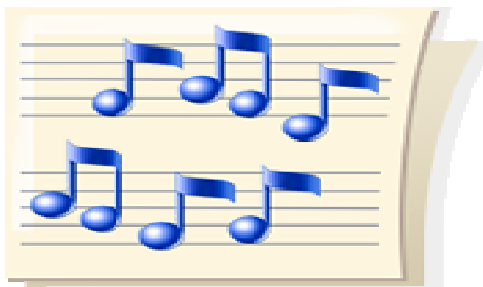

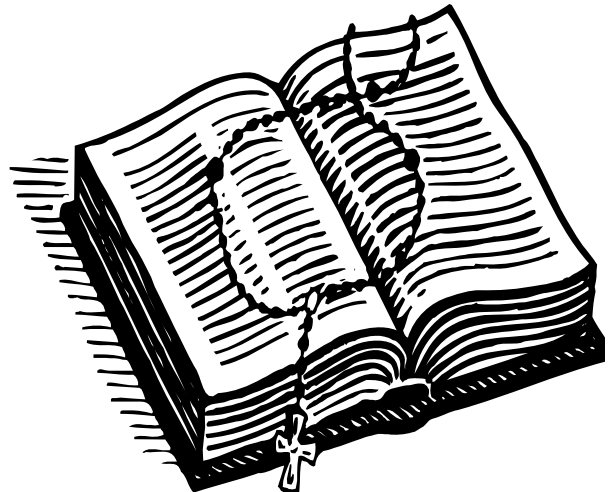

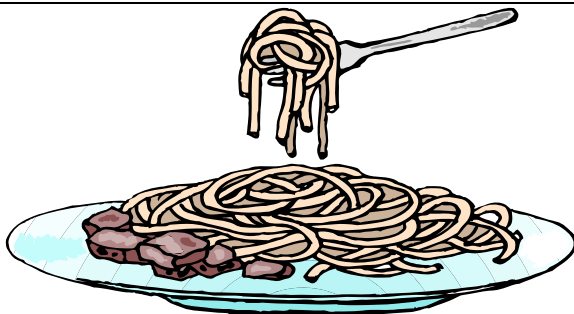
RELAY FOR LIFE

Our Saints

FEBRUARY 10—SCHOLASTICA (480-547) was the twin sister of St. Benedict and is the patron of Benedictine nuns. While still a young girl at home, Scholastica consecrated her life to God, and later went on to found convents for women, just as her brother did for men. Once during their annual visit, Benedict rose to return to his monastery, but Scholastica was not ready for him to leave, so she prayed to God. Such a violent thunderstorm arose that Benedict could not leave the house until the next day. Scholastica is invoked against storms.
