

LENTEN DAY OF PRAYER

Holy Disciples on Saturday, March 30

Enlist the help of your entire parish in praying for your special intentions and join others in praying for theirs. The Day of Prayer begins with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and closes with Benediction before evening Mass.
